Dorking's Natasha Watson, up against Lucy Yates, started slowly but then took control of the first set to win it 6-2. She then lost her first service game of the second set but took the next six games to take the set and match 6-1. Alex Hemsley had a much tighter match with Zoe Robinson and held on to win a closely fought first set 7-5. She then took control of the match, running through the second set to take it 6-2.

The doubles saw the Claygate girls gaining the advantage of an early service break which they held to serve for the match at 5-4. The Dorking girls, in a close game, saved set point and went on the break serve and win a closely contested tie break 7-4. Natasha Watson and Alex Hemsley then ran out 6-2 winners of the second set.
